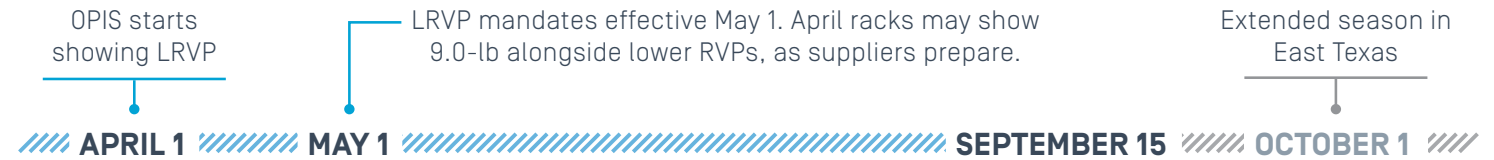


2025 LRVP Season

To help control ozone, most U.S. cities switch to 9.0-lb RVP conventional gasoline in summer unless lower levels are required by RFG mandates, state rules, waiver opt-outs, or voluntary efforts. This year, six Midwestern states opted out of RVP PSI waivers to allow E15 sales without federal exemptions, requiring lower-RVP [LRVP] fuel. OPIS will code these with existing 7.8-lb RVP identifiers. The map below marks opt-out states with a yellow corn cob. In some border areas, both 7.8-lb and 9.0-lb RVP may be offered; OPIS will reflect the appropriate product, with dual-RVP areas shown in red.

Low RVP displayed in OPIS rack reports

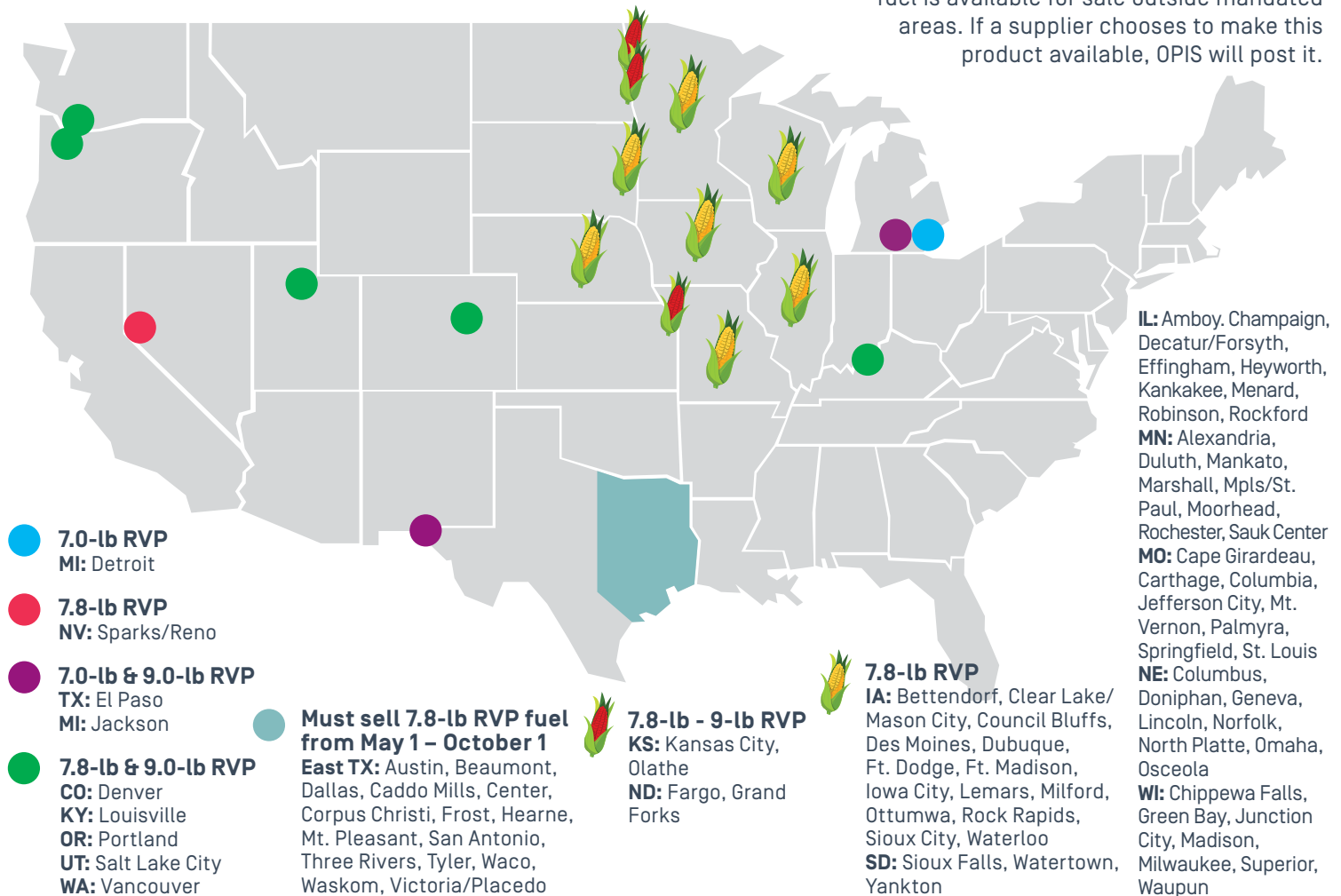


Reformulated Gasoline [RFG]

If a city is part of the federal RFG program, our reports won't specify the RVP. Phoenix, AZ & California are primarily RFG markets, coded CBG [Clean Burning Gasoline] or CaRFG [California RFG] due to geographical requirements.

OPIS U.S. RVP Designations

Additional RVP levels may appear in markets where they are not required if such fuel is available for sale outside mandated areas. If a supplier chooses to make this product available, OPIS will post it.
